LIFE HELP CENTRE FOR CHILD CARE

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ACTIVITY REPORT

1st APRIL-2017 TO 23RD AUGUST 2017

It's a known fact that immediately after Eid i.e. on 9th July 2016 onwards heavy violence in the Kashmir valley broke out. And hence the LIFE HELP CENTRE FOR CHILD CARE was not functioning till March 2017, and the plea of winding up the program was also dropped due to the parents, well wishers and also the staff request to continue the program as it is very much inevitable to run the school having the credibility of being the first of its kind special school in the Kashmir valley also considering the strength of special children.

The entire staff were reported to school during first week of April and made preparations to run the school by maintain the school premises and also the vehicles. The parents been informed to send the children to school as the normalcy prevail in Srinagar area Where our school situates.

Initially the strength was very minimal of 27 and it was increased to 41 during first week of May. Hence the school head arranged for a Parent-Teacher interaction session to convince the parent and the rest of the children were also restored to school. The response was very good and the parents were appraised of their wards development and activities. Individual attention was highlighted to all the parents and critical advice was imparted. Certain feedback was also noted from the parents.

Orthotic consultation was arranged with a prominent Orthotic consultant Mr. Mohammad Yousuf. With the parent's consent he was asked to prepare some orthotic splints and braces for the children, the expense of which would be borne by the parent. However, the said consultant agreed for a healthy concession for the deserving children.

Jammu and Kashmir Football Association (JKFA) had organized a football event named "First Sports Festival 2017 for Disabled Children". The event was attended by institutes working with differently abled children like deaf, dumb and mentally challenged. The event was attended by Hon'ble Chief Minister of J&K, Director Sports Council and other well known dignitaries. LHCCC participated in the event and a team of 11 children accompanied by 5 staff members were attended. The children interacted with personnel associated with the sports fraternity. LHCCC children were involved several activities and showed a very good response towards the event. LHCCC also promoted itself and Project Administrator gave several interviews to media channels were in the need for assimilating and interacting with such differently abled children was much highlighted. It was telecasted in local and regional NEWS channels as well.

LHCCC Srinagar organized two batches of exploratory visits for the students to Sonmarg and Harwan. The children interacted with tourists and also got familiar with the natural surroundings of the beautiful places. This outing for the children came after nearly one and half years and was much loved and anticipated by them.

LHCCC organized a mid day meal for the whole school on 18th July 2017 and were served Non veg which was donated by locals.

The school had one CP chair for elder kids earlier. Another chair was ordered for small kids as well. Due to the fact that our restrooms have only Indian style toilet seats, two portable western style chair commodes were bought. This has helped in managing the requirements better.

Since the building owner needs the premises for their own use, On special request to continue in the same premises been obtained till the end of this academic year i.e., up to December-2017.
